Applicant Requirements:

- (a) The student must be a Teamsters Local 911 member or a Dependent of a Teamsters Local 911 member.
- (b) As of the start of the student's school year, the Teamsters Local 911 member must have been a dues paying member for least four (4) months.
- (c) The student must be in his/her final year in high school **or** must be registered for at least twelve (12) semester hours, or eighteen (18) quarter hours at a regionally accredited college or university in a school year. A college or university is considered to be accredited if it is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges or its regional affiliates.
- (d) The student must remain eligible for the scholarship during the entire school year.
- (e) The student must meet the academic qualifications determined by the Education Committee.
- (f) The student must submit a personal statement in 200 words or less describing the reason(s) he or she should be awarded the scholarship.
- (g) Complete application and attachments, and **official academic transcripts** of the previous academic year must be received by Teamsters Local 911 no later than the **June 30, 2017 deadline date**.
