- 4. Maximiliano "Max" Lopez - Former Recording Secretary of Local 911 and Chief Steward at Palm Springs Unified School District.**

Requirements

- The student must be a Teamsters Local 911 member or a dependent of a Teamsters Local 911 member.
- As of the start of the student's school year, the Teamsters Local 911 member must have been a dues paying member for at least four (4) months.
- The student must be in his/her final year in high school or must be registered for at least twelve (12) semester hours, or eighteen (18) quarter hours at a regionally accredited college or university in a school year. A college or university is considered to be accredited if it is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges or its regional affiliates.
- The student must remain eligible for the scholarship during the entire school year.
- The student must meet the academic qualifications determined by the Education Committee.
- The student must submit a personal statement in 200 words or less describing the reason(s) he or she should be awarded the scholarship.
- Complete application and attachments, and official academic transcripts of the previous academic year must be received by Teamsters Local 911 **no later than the June 30, 2019 deadline date.**
